The flower beds aren't just prettier - they've become a space that will spark joy, curiosity, and learning every single day. The difference their work has made is beyond measure.

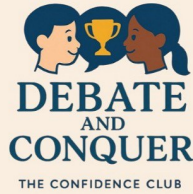
